Naming the Oliver D. Kingsley, Jr. and Sally Y. Kingsley Portico and Courtyard

Whereas, Oliver D. Kingsley, Jr. graduated from Auburn University with the bachelor of science degree in engineering physics in 1966, and Sally Y. Kingsley graduated with the bachelor of science degree in secondary school mathematics in 1966; and

Whereas, Mr. Kingsley is the former president and COO of Exelon Corporation and president of the World Association of Nuclear Operators, and is widely recognized as a leader in the nuclear power industry; and

Whereas, Mr. Kingsley is a member of the National Academy of Engineering and the State of Alabama Engineering Hall of Fame and has time and again distinguished himself as an involved alumnus and donor; and

Whereas, his contributions to Auburn University constitute membership in the Samford Society and 1856 Society; and

Whereas, his involvement with the College of Engineering includes membership in the Engineering Eagles Society, Keystone Society, and the Auburn Alumni Engineering Council, and he is chairman of the Engineering Campaign Leadership Team; and

Whereas, Mr. Kingsley has made significant contributions to the Samuel Ginn College of Engineering and recently committed \$1,000,000 to the "It Begins at Auburn" Campaign in support of the Shelby Center.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that Auburn University recognizes the service and generosity of Oliver D. Kingsley, Jr. and his wife Sally by naming the west portico and courtyard of the Shelby Center as the Oliver D. Kingsley, Jr. and Sally Y. Kingsley Portico and Courtyard.
